This letter is a reminder about the summer activities for the 2014 Saxon Marching Band.

<u>Sectionals:</u> All band members will meet every Monday afternoon 2:00-4:30pm in the music department **beginning Monday, July 7**th. Front ensemble and drumline will rehearse until 5:00pm. If you have a conflict, you need to contact your section leader beforehand (see below). During these rehearsals, we will be learning the music for the fall and marching fundamentals. <u>Band Camp</u>: All band members must attend band camp the week of August 11-15. During band camp, we will be learning all of the movement on the field for our fall show.
