

Hello Band Students and Families!

Please see below for important summer information for the 2018 Saxon Marching Band (SMB). We are happy to announce this year's marching band halftime show, **Earth, Wind, and Fire**, featuring:

**Sectionals:** All band members will meet on **Monday and Wednesday afternoons 1:00-4:00pm** in the music department **beginning Monday, July 9<sup>th</sup>**. During these rehearsals, we will be learning the music for the fall and marching fundamentals. If you are in town, we highly recommend attending all sectionals. If you are on vacation or cannot attend, please contact your section leader (**contact information on the back side of this sheet**).

Summer Sectionals will focus on the Halftime Show, SHS Fight Song, Star Spangled Banner, and Parade Tune (*TBD*). Focus on these as you begin practicing. Start working on memorizing these songs for band camp (we will teach you how to do this during sectionals). The rest of this packet contains mostly pop charts that we play in the stands for football and basketball (fun music to try this summer – we will not get to these until the school year begins).

**Band Camp:** All band members must attend band camp the week of **July 30 – August 3**. During band camp, we will be learning all of the movement on the field for our fall show. **Attendance at the entirety of band camp is required**, as it is incredibly difficult to catch up once school begins. **Jazz Band Auditions:** Audition packets will be available at sectionals beginning on July 9<sup>th</sup>. Auditions will take place in September. All are encouraged to audition.

**School-Owned Instruments:** SHS provides marching instruments for the following sections: tenor saxophones, baritone saxophones, French horns (mellophones), baritones, tubas (sousaphones), and percussion. If you need an instrument other than one listed above for marching band or would like to pick an instrument earlier than July 9<sup>th</sup>, please email Mr. Graffeo. Concert instruments NOT used in marching band (i.e. bass clarinets, French horns) will be issued later in the summer.
